Welcome to the Central Library @ CUO

The Central University of Orissa has been established by an Act of Parliament under the Central Universities Act, 2009 (No. 3C of 2009). It is one of the 15 new Central Universities established by the Government of India during the UGC XI Plan period to address the concerns of "equity and access" and as per the policy of the Government of India to increase the access to quality higher education by people in educationally less developed districts which have a Graduate Enrolment Ratio of less than the national average of 11%. Koraput District of Odisha comes within the KBK region (Koraput, Bolangir and Kalahandi) which is considered as an extremely underdeveloped region of the State of Odisha. These three districts of the State are known for tribal culture, because majority of the people here belong to ST and SC categories.

In any academic institution, Library plays a vital role in supporting and furthering the academic and research mission. The CUO Library aims to be a leading academic research library for the region and for the nation. The mission of the library is to share and promote knowledge to its users by effective dissemination of information through cutting edge technologies. It also has the mission to manage its intellectual output for posterity by using suitable latest technologies.

At present Central Library is operating from two campuses. One from Landiguda (03 departments) and one from Sunabeda (11 departments).

Anti Plagiarism Software (from INFLIBNET)

Urkund: URKUND is a completely automated system against plagiarism. URKUND's system checks all documents against three central source areas: The Internet, published material and previously submitted student material (e.g. Memoranda, case studies and examination works).

Arrangement of the Collection

All books in print are classified according to the Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) and arranged by classification number (subject wise) on the shelf. The detailed shelf guides are also provided in the stack area for easy location. One can access to the Central Library collection through its Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC). All the books are kept in the shelves in open access and one can directly go to the shelves and pick the books as per his/her choice and get it issued from the circulation counter. Newly arrived books are available for display in the new arrivals section. Print journals are arranged in the alphabetical order.

Borrowing Facilities

Central Library provides different borrowing privileges to different category of users. On special requests, outside scholars are also allowed to use the library facilities for a short period to collect data to support their research activities on the production of a written request from their institution. Reference books can not be issued. The different membership categories, number of books eligible and their loan period is as follows:

Late Fee (Applies to all categories of users)

Overdue charges will be levied after due date @ Re.1/- per day per book. Once a recall notice is served for a book and if the member does not return the book within a week overdue charges @ Rs. 5/- per day will be levied.

LOSS OF BOOK

The borrower has to return the same edition of the book with Rs.20 as processing fees or the defaulter will be charged 10 times the cost of the book in the present conversion rate along with Rs. 20 extra as processing fee from the member towards book recovery cost. If the book of a multi volume set is lost or damaged the concerned member shall be liable to replace the whole set or pay 10 times the cost of the volume on the above line.
