- 4. For regional language, the document must be prepared using *Unicode compliant font* (details below) otherwise plagiarism check cannot be performed.

- 5. According to <u>UGC Regulation</u>, 2018, the similarity checks for plagiarism shall exclude the following:
  - i. All quoted work reproduced with all necessary permission and/or attribution.
  - ii. All references, bibliography, table of content, preface and acknowledgements.
  - iii. All generic terms, laws, standard symbols and standards equations.
- 6. University has permitted similarity **up to 10%** (<u>as per UGC Regulation, 2018</u>). However, there is a provision of **penalties in case of plagiarism in submission of thesis and dissertations:-**

Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) shall impose penalty considering the severity of the Plagiarism.

- i. Level 0: Similarities upto 10% Minor Similarities, no penalty.
- ii. **Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40%** Such student shall be asked to submit a revised script within a stipulated time period not exceeding 6 months.
- iii. **Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60%** Such student shall be debarred from submitting a revised script for a period of one year.
- iv. Level 3: Similarities above 60% -Such student registration for that programme shall be cancelled.
- **Note 1: Penalty on repeated plagiarism** Such student shall be punished for the plagiarism of one level higher than the previous level committed by him/her. In case where plagiarism of highest level is committed then the punishment for the same shall be operative.
- Note 2: Penalty in case where the degree/credit has already been obtained If plagiarism is proved on a date later than the date of award of degree or credit as the case may be then his/her degree or credit shall be put in abeyance for a period recommended by the IAIP and approved by the Head of the Institution.
